

Camp Nubar 2022 Summer Guidelines

Please note, we will be closely monitoring the guidelines as released by the CDC & NYS DOH

Medical Protocol

- **COVID 19 Vaccination**
 - All campers & counselors will be required to show proof of full COVID 19 vaccination.
- **Pre-Camp COVID Testing:**
 - All campers & counselors will be required to provide proof of a negative PCR test within 72 hours prior to their arrival at camp.
- **Suspected Case Protocol:**
 - Any camper or staff member who has COVID symptoms will be isolated pending results of a COVID test.
 - Any camper or staff member who test positive for COVID will be required to leave camp immediately.
 - Any camper who tests positive for COVID will be allowed to return 10 days after their positive tests, pending recovery from all symptoms and proof of a negative rapid test.
 - Close contacts of a COVID-positive camper or staff member will be tested.



Camper Arrival & Departure

- All campers must **arrive** by car
- Camper arrival & departure times will be assigned to families
- Buses to St. Thomas Armenian Church in Tenafly, NJ for **returning** campers at the end of each session
